VENDOR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Each vendor is responsible to clean area at the close of the show.
- Any extension/power cords used must be heavy duty and secured to the ground to provide safety for pedestrian traffic. Vendors must supply their own electric cords and any table needed. There will be limited 120 volt electricity available and vendors needing it should call to verify availability.
- Love Civic Center has overnight camping available in a designated area only. Contact the Civic Center directly to reserve a space at (903) 739-9912. Dump station is available free of charge. Vendors may not sell from campsites.
- Sales tax collections and payment are solely the Vendor's responsibility.
- Food Vouchers for Judges and Car Show Staff will present a ticket to a food vendor of their choice for food, good for one meal only. Prior to 2:00 PM a staff person will stop by to collect vouchers and tally up totals and pay each vendor.
